- 1) Vendors will have to check in at the registration booth before unloading and setting up.
- 2) Vendor agrees to not sell any artifacts or religious items of any tribe (including: sage, tobacco, cedar, sweet grass, or other herbs, or pipestone, pipes, etc.)
- 3) Vendor agrees not to drive or park motor vehicles on and around the Powwow area. Vendor agrees not to drive or park on any undesignated areas. Vendors and organizations will be responsible for traffic and/or parking citations. **Vendors are not allowed to drive on grass areas.**
- 4) Vendor agrees to assume full risks of lost money and/or vendor property arising from any costs.
- 5) NASA, NASP and the University of California will not be responsible for any personal injury.
- 6) Vendors will provide their own ELECTRIC GENERATOR & FIRE EXTINGUISHER.
- 7) Vendor booths are **REQUIRED** to be either staked down or be weighted down properly.
- 8) UCR, NASP and NASA are **NOT** responsible for loss or damage to property due to weather conditions.
- 9) Vendors will be asked to donate one item with a value no less than \$20 to NASA.
- 10) Vendor spaces will be given out on a First Come, First Serve basis during Set-up.
- 11) UCR Health and Safety protocols established in alignment with guidance from the C.D.C., state and local health authorities. (i.e.. face coverings, social distancing, Daily Wellness Checks, etc.)

**UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, RIVERSIDE  
TEMPORARY VENDOR PERMIT AND  
INDEMNIFICATION/HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT**

Native American Student Association (NASA), Native American Student Programs (NASP)

1. In consideration for permission to sell Arts and Crafts as part of the Pow-Wow sponsored by NASA & NASP and being held on the University of California, Riverside campus on May 27 - 29, 2022, Vendor shall defend, indemnify, and hold The Regents of the University of California, its officers, agents, and employees from, harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, expense (including reasonable attorneys' fees), or claims for injury or damages arising out of the permission herein granted but only in proportion to and to the extent such liability, loss, expense, attorneys' fees, or claims for injury or damages are caused by or result from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of Vendor, its officers, agents, or employees.

It is expressly understood that, for the purposes of the permission granted herein, Vendor is an Independent Contractor and not an employee or agent of the University or of the student group named herein. It is further agreed and understood that Vendor is not covered under the University's Workers' Compensation self-insurance program or any other University insurance program. Any injury to Vendor arising out of, or resulting from, the permission granted herein is the responsibility of Vendor.

2. Property Left Un-attended/ Overnight on University premises. There is no assumption of liability by the University of California, Riverside campus and The Regents of the University of California for property left unattended or overnight. Vendor fully understands and assumes the risk for any property left unattended or overnight and release the University of California, Riverside campus, and The Regents of the University of California from liability for any damage or loss to vendor's property. These risks may include, but are not limited to, damage or loss of property due to theft, vandalism, or weather conditions. There may be other risks not known or reasonably foreseeable.
